

**OHIO HIGH SCHOOL BASKETBALL COACHES ASSOCIATION**  
**September 24, 2006 – 9:00 AM at Hyatt Regency, Columbus OH**

- I. **Welcome - President Joe Balogh** welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- II. **Prayer – Bob Von Kaenel** led us in prayer.
- III. **Roll Call – Bob Von Kaenel** called roll. Absent were – Sean O’Toole, Amy Manco, Bill Brewer
- IV. **Treasurer’s Report – Wayne Wiseman** – Approved 1<sup>st</sup>- Bob Walsh 2<sup>nd</sup>- Bob Miller
- V. **OHSAA Proposal - President Balogh** talked about the 90 quarter rule passing, and being adopted this year. He also stated that the individual workout sessions failed.
- VI. **Ball Contract Presentations** – Jerry Williams from Rawlings Company presented us with information and explained the current contract, and future considerations. John Salay from Spalding made a presentation and explained what they had to offer to the organization. Both were taken under advisement for the Fall Meeting.
- VII. **Minutes from Executive Meeting – July 18, 2006 at Indianapolis -**
  - a. State Tournament Program – PR director **Larry Wilson** asked for the OHSBCA to add a page to the program. 1<sup>st</sup>- **Tom Rettig** 2<sup>nd</sup> – **Jeff Heistan**. Motion passed 14-0.
  - b. Constitutional Items – It was recommended that N/S Game All-Star coaches be selected only one time, unless no one else is eligible, and the Paul Walker Award be given to someone nearing retirement, unless no one else is eligible. 1<sup>st</sup>- **Dan Schwieterman** 2<sup>nd</sup> – **Joe Dunlevy** Motion passed by 14-0 vote.
  - c. Certificate Awards – The executive committee suggested having the same logo design on all our awards, and giving the printing contract to J&K Printing who already does the *Hooplines* Magazine. It was suggested that all companies currently doing printing bring a logo and that we table who is given the business until the October Meeting.
  - d. **National Association of Basketball Coaches Directors** – It was decided at the meeting in Indianapolis that the group of directors from all the states in attendance would give our organization this name.
  - e. Adding FG% with 3-point and free throw to our awards – After discussion we decided to add FG% and handout TOP 20 awards to each individual in each category. 1<sup>st</sup>- **Dan Schwieterman** 2<sup>nd</sup> – **Bob Walsh** Passed 14-0.
  - f. News Releases – **Larry Wilson** asked that directors and officer submit to him electronic e-mail contacts for their local areas. All new releases will be done electronically in the future. This will be a large savings to the OHSBCA.
  - g. Girls N/S Coaches – PR Director **Larry Wilson** asked for help in finding information about previous N/S All-Star Game coaches.
  - h. Chairpersons – **Larry Wilson** asked that biographies, pictures and any necessary information be sent to him in a timely fashion when awards are selected.
  - i. OHSBCA Pen – **Larry Wilson** would like information with electronic e-mail for coaches and athletic directors in each district so he can contact them in early December if they have not joined the state membership.
  - j. 700 Wins Award – What do we do to honor **Joe Petrocelli, Dick Kortokrax, Jack Van Reeth, Karen Wittrock**? All four have over 700 victories. After discussion, it was voted to give a \$1,000 dollar scholarship in the names of Joe Petrocelli, and **Dick Kortokrax**. 1<sup>st</sup> – **Dan Gorski** 2<sup>nd</sup>- **Bob**

**Walsh** Motion Passed 14-0. The Girls Advisory Committee will meet to discuss how to honor Van Reeth and Wittrock. Bring ideas to the fall meeting.

- k. Stipends – **President Balogh** handed out information on increasing the stipends for Treasurer, Public Relations Director, and Webmaster, and to add stipends for President, 2<sup>nd</sup>- VP, 1<sup>st</sup>-VP, 1<sup>st</sup> Past President and 2<sup>nd</sup> Past President. No action was taken. Tabled until the fall meeting.

- VIII. **Past President's Breakfast – Dave Froelich** – He suggested that we have a breakfast during the State Tournament Weekend. Ideas were offered as to when to hold it, and any decision was tabled until the fall meeting. It was agreed that officers and directors should attend this breakfast.
- IX. **Asst. Coach of the Year – Bob Von Kaenel** – Discussion was held about having a winner in each division. Any decision was tabled until the fall meeting.
- X. **District Concerns** – Please send them to **President Balogh** by October 9<sup>th</sup> so they can be placed on the agenda
- XI. **North/South Coaches – President Balogh** presented a list of all District Champion coaches from last season. Directors will nominate at the fall meeting.
- XII. **SEI AWARD** – District Directors from Districts 13-16 should have a boys/girls coach nominee e-mailed to **President Balogh** prior to October 9<sup>th</sup> so they can be placed on the agenda
- XIII. **HOF Museum – Doc Daugherty, Don Henderson** - Doc and Don gave a summary of the banquet held in May. They told the group that DVD's are available for \$15.95 of the Museum Banquet, and that they are progressing forward with building ideas, and future selections. They reminded members to join this organization.
- XIV. **Century Awards & Bob Arnzen Awards** – The deadline has been adjusted from June 1<sup>st</sup> to September 1<sup>st</sup> and should be submitted to **Wayne Wiseman** in a timely fashion. Wayne handed out a list of Century/Arnzen Winners for this year.
- XV. **Directory – Larry Wilson/Bob Von Kaenel** – Both requested current mailing addresses and e-mail accounts for their mailing purposes.
- XVI. **OHSBCA Projects – Larry Wilson** – Larry asked directors and officers to submit names of coaches who could assist with Top 100 Workouts, Mentoring and any other OHSBCA projects. Obviously, our goal is to get many members to become active with the association.
