

OHIO HIGH SCHOOL BASKETBALL COACHES ASSOCIATION
March 21, 2007 – 12:30 PM at Holiday Inn on the Lane, Columbus OH

1. Welcome by President **Dave Froelich**.
2. **Bob Von Kaenel**, Secretary, led us in prayer.
3. The following guests were present: Kris Spriggs, Joe LaBella
4. **Bob Von Kaenel** read roll call. Absent – Tom Woodford (GAC), Paul Wayne, Rich Venuto
5. **FALL MEETING MINUTES - 1st Walsh - 2nd Persin** to approve the minutes of the fall meeting after amending the replaced coaches for the Girls North/South All-Star Game. Donn Burrows(Fenwick) replaced the South D-III/IV Coach. Motion Carried.
6. **TREASURER’S REPORT - 1st Miller – 2nd Nossaman** to approve the Treasurer’s Report. Motion Carried.
7. Membership Report. **Wayne Wiseman** reported membership at 3,903 members. This is slightly higher than last year. Wayne reported that elections will be held for Treasurer, Odd-numbered districts, and GAC member 1/4, 8/9, 10/11, 13/14 **1st – Walsh 2nd - Dunlevy**
8. **Dr. Dan Ross**, OHSAA Commissioner discussed points from an executive meeting. These were: 1) Officials Voting procedures – suggestions were made to make the process more clear. Dr. Ross stated that there are changes being made now and the system will be re-done 2) Rawlings Contract 3) State Tournament Seating – Why are head coaches still in the 300 sections – Dr. Ross stated that he will continue to look into this matter 4) Individual Workouts proposal – we suggested a need for this to combat AAU programs 5) He also discussed tier seating prices being used in the future for the state tournament 6) He also a “foundation game” for charitable contributions may be considered by the board of control 7) We discussed a FanFest at the tournament being held in the Auxiliary Gym 8) Transfer rules were discussed
9. **National Guard Proposal** – They proposed to donate \$1500.00 dollars to our association if they could hang banners, make announcements at the N/S Game, and at our Top 100 Showcase. **1st-Rettig 2nd –Gorski** Motion Carried. We accepted their offer and they will work with Larry Wilson on particular ideas.
10. **Rawlings Contract** – President Froelich said the deal is nearly completed. We will receive \$50,000 dollars annually as a minimum. The balls will have a cap price of \$36.00 dollars for the next 3 years, and they will continue to purchase balls, uniforms, and other equipment for the OHSBCA.
