1. **WELCOME** - President **Dave Froelich**.
2. **Tom Rettig**, District 9, led us in prayer. A moment of silence was offered in remembrance of Bill Brewer, former Princeton HS, and District 16 Director.

4. **ROLL CALL** – **Bob Von Kaenel**. Absent – Rich Venuto.
5. **FALL MEETING MINUTES** - **1st Walsh** - **2nd Gorski** to approve the minutes of the fall meeting after amending the replaced coaches for the North/South All-Star Games. Connie Lyon (Findlay HS) replaced Caroline Daugherty, and Jack Greynolds Jr. (GlenOak HS) replaced Eric Flannery. Motion Carried.
6. **TREASURER’S REPORT** - **1st Miller** – **2nd Shoemaker** to approve the Treasurer’s Report. It was suggested to have the constitution put on-line, and eliminate it from the issue of ***Hooplines***. Dr. Ross explained that Boys/Girls Basketball, and Ice hockey are the only sports that fall under this jurisdiction.
