MINUTES of FALL MEETING – OCTOBER 18, 2010

She answered questions about our organization NOT receiving a commendation for the monies we have donated to the foundation. **Jerry Snodgrass – OHSAA Asst. Commissioner** – He offered some insight to the rules meeting procedures, and the starting times of this year's state tournament games

 - C) **Past President's Breakfast** – Jerry Snodgrass said the OHSAA will help us obtain a room at the Schottenstein Center for Saturday Morning of the Boys State Tournament for our Breakfast.
 - D) **Rules Meetings** – Jerry Snodgrass reported procedures for online and in-person meetings..
 - E) **State Tournament Sites** – Discussion was held about use of Nationwide Arena in the future.

F) Proposals – We discussed the 22-game proposal and the individual workout proposal in-depth and were told nothing was finalized
