MINUTES OF WINTER MEETING – MARCH 23, 2011

1. **WELCOME** - President **Tom Barrick**.
2. **Bob Von Kaenel**, Secretary led us in prayer.
3. **ROLL CALL** – **Bob Von Kaenel**. Absent – Dave Froelich, Rich Venuto.
4. **FALL MEETING MINUTES** – **Bob Von Kaenel - 1st McBride - 2nd Dunlevy** to approve the minutes of the Oct. 18, 2010 meeting.
