- I. Welcome - President Tom Barrick** welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- II. Prayer – Bob Von Kaenel** led us in prayer.
- III. Roll Call – Bob Von Kaenel** called roll. Absent were – Dan Gorski, Sean O’Toole, Kris Spriggs, Rich Hoyt, Ed Foulk, Jill Phillips, and Rich Venuto. Dave Boyce (D-7), Steve Ater (D-14), Keith Westrich (D-8), and Scott Davis (D-10) were there as district representatives. Bob requested an e-mail update from all officers.
- IV. Treasurer’s Report – Pat Carroll** – was accepted – **1st – Walsh, 2nd- Romick**. Pat reported that our total account was less than last year at this time.
- V.
