

**OHIO HIGH SCHOOL BASKETBALL COACHES ASSOCIATION
SUMMER EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING
COLUMBUS AIRPORT MARRIOTT – COLUMBUS, OHIO
JULY 14, 2013**

- I. Welcome – President Tom Barrick** welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- II. Attendance** – Officers present were Wally Vickers, Tom Barrick, Greg Nossaman, Joe Balogh, Bob Von Kaenel, Scott Bardall, Pat Carroll, Larry Wilson.
- III. Financial Report – Pat Carroll** reported balances and expenditures for all OHSBCA accounts. He reported that we had roughly \$84,000.00 in our account, and gave estimates on outstanding expenditures for the remainder of the year.
- IV. Membership Report – Pat Carroll** presented a breakdown of total membership. Breakdown was Boys Head Coaches:(671), Boys Assistant Coaches (1,398), Girls Head Coaches (610), Girls Assistant Coaches (1,063) for a Total Membership of 3,742. We had an additional 24 non-coaches join the association for a Grand Total of 3,764. Discussion was held on ways to try and maintain current totals, and other ways to try and increase membership.
- V. NHSBCA Report – Tom Barrick** discussed the plans on the National “Rising Stars” tournament in Indianapolis July 15-17. Pat Carroll and Larry Wilson would be attending the NHSBCA Meeting. Tom, Pat, Larry and Greg Nossaman all would be attending the Rising Stars Tournament.
- VI. National Federation Coach of the Year Candidates** – Ed Heintschel of Toledo St. John’s was selected as the Ohio Boys representative and Jerry Sigler of Sylvania Northview as the Ohio Girls representative.
- VII. 2014 Larry Wilson Award Winner** – Dave Krauss of Deshler, Ohio was selected as the 2014 recipient of the Larry Wilson Award.
- VIII. Hall of Fame / Top 100 / North-South Weekend** – Pat Carroll reported that all workers for all events must be paid with a check; No cash payments. The rental agreement with Capital University for 2014-16 was discussed, and it was decided to continue holding events there. Top 100 Showcases at Capital and Denison financial reports were presented. Discussion was held about the possibility of having Top 100 Showcase event tied into the selection of Rising Stars players for the future. Should we have the top 5 players at Top 100 be included in the selection for the Rising Stars Team? North-South Weekend went well. Discussion was held about the Marriott Hotel and what they could possibly do to reward us for using their venue. We will continue to assign duties to District Directors and Girls District Directors for that weekend.
- IX. Proposals – Tom Barrick.** Our videotape exchange proposal for Regional Tournaments was defeated by the Board of Control. It did not go to a vote, due to a lack of a second to the motion.
- X. OHSBCA Coaches Scholarships** - It was decided that beginning in 2014 all scholarship winners must be present to receive the \$1,000.00 scholarship from the association. Payment will be made at the presentation. If you cannot attend you will not receive the monetary award.
- XI. State Tournament Ticket List – Pat Carroll** will take over the duties of organizing this list from Dave Froelich. He will gather the lists from Hall of Fame and OHSBCA to submit to Molly Downard at the OHSAA.

XII. Turnover In Leadership Positions – Discussion was held in regards to future officer positions. We will attempt to get younger coaches involved in these positions. Everyone will try to get names to Tom Barrick for possible candidates. Leadership and committee positions held by Dave Froelich were discussed. We will ask him to continue with us and help mentor people who may be chosen to handle some of his duties with SEI, Tournament Tickets and COY chair positions. It was also suggested that we get people to mirror and assist Larry Wilson in his Public Relations position. Adam Hall from Tuscarawas Central Catholic was suggested as someone who could help in this position.

XIII. Hall of Honor – Odd Numbered Districts (1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15) should send the recipients to Greg Nossaman by October 4th so they can be announced at the October 14th meeting.

XIV. OHSBCA Personnel – Elections will be held in the Fall 2013. The position of Secretary, Odd Numbered Districts (1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15) and Girls District Directors (1 & 4, 8 & 9, 10 & 11, 13 & 14). XV. Public Relations Report – Larry Wilson – A list of concerns and ideas were (1) Named the new District 8 Director as Keith Westrick. (2) Gave totals and cost of State Tournament rooms at the Fairfield Inn for next year. (3) Asked if it was difficult to get monies owed from ads for North-South Game? (4) NFHS COY Nominees – It was suggested that they receive an award from OHSBCA at the State Tournament for their accomplishments. (5) Should there be a mandatory meeting for each district each year? (6) It was suggested to add information to the North-South questionnaire in regards to former family members who also participated in the classic. (7) We needed to change the name of our Mr. and Ms. Basketball Award. A change was made to Mr. OHSBCA and Ms. OHSBCA. (8) It was voted and agreed that future HOF Inductees would receive a Hall of Fame Ring. Past Inductees could purchase a ring if interested. We also voted to change the expenses for current inductees to 1 room for 1 night for the Hall of Fame Banquet. (9) It was voted to increase the pay for all-star game officials from \$30 to \$50 for North-South Games. (10) Question on why no Hall of Fame Photos were on the Jumbo Tron at the State Tournament.

XVI. New Business – Tom Barrick discussed proposals from “Easy Stat” from Pittsburgh and “Sport n Shoes.” Easy Stat is a program similar to “Huddle.” They will present more information at our clinic, and explain their process in more detail in future meetings. Sport n Shoes is a sporting goods store who will manufacture coaching gear of all types with our OHSBCA logo.

XVII. Old Business – The committee expressed concerns with the Rawlings Contract, and items that may have been added after we viewed the contract. Concerns included the mandatory use of the Rawlings ball for Junior High games next season. More items were discussed and Tom Barrick will continue discussions with Rawlings and the OHSAA.
