### Howland Boys Basketball Team Makes an Impact off the Court

The Howland boys' basketball program has partnered with Hillside Rehabilitation Hospital. Hillside Hospital is licensed acute care hospital, specializing in physical rehabilitation medicine. It offers comprehensive rehabilitation services to those requiring intensive therapy. Each Saturday throughout the season two Howland boys' basketball players provide patient transportation assistance within the facility. Volunteering players assist patients in wheelchairs to and from their prescribed physical rehab areas. Players are at the facility from 8am until 12:30pm. The program began the first weekend in November and will continue into March. It is a wonderful partnership that allows Howland boys' basketball to give back to the community. The volunteer opportunities are coordinated by Howland head coach Bill Bogan and Hillside Volunteer services coordinator Leslie Miller.

### Denny Schrock Earns win 500 as Chippewa Coach

On December 12th, 2013, Coach Denny Schrock of Chippewa High School earned his 500th win as the Chippewa girls coach. During his tenure at Chippewa, the Lady Chipps have won 103 straight league games (1990-1998), 13 consecutive league titles (1998-2002) and 21 league titles total, 14 district titles, and one state runner-up (1994). Coach Schrock's overall coaching record is 523-137 and his record at Chippewa is 507-110. Congrats to Denny Schrock on his coaching milestone.
