BARRICK'S TERM AS OHSBCA PRESIDENT COMES TO AN END

President Tom Barrick of Wheelersburg High School presided over his final meeting as President of the OHSBCA at the Clinic Meeting on Sunday, September 29, 2013. Tom has been the OHSBCA's President from October, 2010 until September, 2013. To his credit, Tom has streamlined our organization tremendously with his organizational skills. He has been a tireless individual and has made our association a leader in the State of Ohio when it comes to coaches associations. Some of his accomplishments are as follows:

1. After 5 years of requesting for a 22-game schedule, the OHSAA approved the 22-game schedule for 2012-2013 season. Wally Vickers, the previous President, instituted the drive for the increase in games and it finally came to fruition during the 2012-2013 basketball season.
2. Created the Larry Wilson Award in 2011-2012 for Outstanding Contributors to the OHSBCA. The Award is given to coaches who have made outstanding contributions to the association after they retired from active coaching.
3. Created a Chronological Calendar for all District Directors which allows directors to simplify their duties
4. Created a Major Change in Executive Officers Terms from a two year term to a three year term, reducing the number of officers from seven to five.
5. Changed the title of Girls Advisory Committee to Girls District Directors and they were given voting privileges.
6. President Barrick was able to secure a 5 year basketball contract with Rawlings Sporting Goods Company, Inc. and the OHSAA which was just recently signed making "RAWLINGS" THE BASKETBALL OF THE OHSBCA UNTIL JULY, 2018.

We as an association wish to "THANK" Tom for all his has done to make our association as great as it is. Tom will not be riding off into the sunset not just yet with his lovely wife, Kim, but still has another 3 years as Past President, and we as an association will have his vast knowledge for that period of time.

GREG NOSSAMAN TAKES OVER AS PRESIDENT

Greg Nossaman of Olentangy Liberty High School takes over the Presidency of the OHSBCA on Monday, October 14, 2013. Greg comes to the position after serving 3 years as 1st Vice President. He also has been in charge of the OHSBCA Coaches Hall of Fame Nominations and Player of the Year Nominations for boys. Greg's coaching experience has been at Ridgedale and Willard High School before taking over at Olentangy Liberty High School in 2008. Before coming to Olentangy Liberty, he had won 5 district titles, 5 Northern Ohio League Titles, had a Final Four Team in 2001, was District Coach of the Year 3 times, and D2 State Coach of the Year in 2004.

Greg has had a successful run at Liberty. His teams were Ohio Capital Conference Champions in 2012 and 2013. In 2012 Liberty was District Champions with a 21-3 record and in 2013 they were District Runner-ups with a record of 23-2. Greg was OCC Coach of the Year in 2012 and 2013, In 2012, he was the Division I State Coach of the Year for the Associated Press and the OHSBCA. His record at Olentangy Liberty is 82-33 (for 5 years) and his overall record now stands at 281-134.
