MEETING MINUTES

WELCOME – President Greg Nossaman welcomed everyone to the meeting.

ATTENDANCE – Officers present were Wally Vickers, Tom Barrick, Greg Nossaman, Joe Balogh, Bob Von Kaenel, Scott Bardall, Pat Carroll, Larry Wilson. Adam Hall was also in attendance.

FINANCIAL REPORT – Pat Carroll reported balances and expenditures for all OHSBCA accounts. He reported that we had roughly \$55,000.00 in our account, and gave estimates on outstanding expenditures for the remainder of the year. He also gave reports on each category and stated we would spend around \$250,000 by the end of this year.

MEMBERSHIP COMMUNICATION – Pat Carroll presented a breakdown of total membership. Discussion was held on ways to try and maintain current totals, and other ways to try and increase membership. We also discussed the number of *Hooplines* to be sent to each school in the future. The consensus was to send 4 per school. We also discussed the possibility of online publication of the magazine. We agreed that we should continue to send the OHSBCA Newsletter to all membership. We also discussed other ways to register for membership. Maybe the possibility of an amount for each school to pay, instead of individuals.

NHSBCA MEETING – Tom Barrick. Tom discussed the plans on the National “Rising Stars” tournament in Indianapolis July 13-15. Tom and Greg Nossaman would be attending the NABCD Meeting. They would be attending the Rising Stars Tournament and the meetings. Larry Wilson and Dave Froelich will be honored at this year’s meetings.

HOF/TOP 100 SHOWCASE/N-S WEEKEND – Pat Carroll submitted financial reports for all of these events. Top 100 Showcases at Capital and Denison financial reports were presented. We will continue to assign duties to D.D. & G.D.D. for that weekend. A discussion was held about ways to decrease expenses of the N/S Game and to improve the order of events for the Top 100 and the Hall of Fame Dinner. Several suggestions were considered, including the possibility of only one boy, and one girl N/S Game each year. Ideas will be presented at the Clinic Meeting.

HALL OF FAME PROPOSAL – Discussion was held to add a clause to the HOF requirements for eligibility for the Hall of Fame. The new proposal changes criteria to:

1) Coaches Varsity for 20 years 2) Won 300 varsity games 3) Was a member of the OHSBCA for at least 10 years 4) Achieved tournament success 5) Retired from coaching for one full season before his/her induction date, **or have coached for 30+ years** 6) Other criteria – Active in the OHSBCA as an officer/director; Coached in the state all-star game.

STATE TOURNAMENT TICKET LIST – Pat Carroll will continue to organize this list. He will gather the lists from HOF and OHSBCA to submit to Molly Downard at the OHSAA.

LEADERSHIP POSITIONS – Had discussion about future positions of officers.
